

How to: Condoms!

Step-by-step guide



- 1 Check the expiration date on the condom. Squeeze the condom wrapper to check for an air bubble. If you see an air bubble, that means the package is sealed, and good to use.
- 2 Slide the condom to one edge of the wrapper, and tear the other side of the wrapper, so you don't accidentally tear the condom.
- 3 Place the rolled condom on the tip of the penis/sex-toy. Pinch the tip of the condom to make sure you keep about half an inch of room at the tip! This is so that there is room for semen ("cum") at the top of the condom during ejaculation ("cumming"), so that the semen ("cum") doesn't leak out the bottom of the condom or break it.
- 4 Make sure the condom is on correctly:
 - If it looks like a sombrero, it's on the right way
 - If it looks like Smurf's hat, then you need to flip it over.
 - If it is difficult to roll down, it's probably on upside down.
- 5 If you put the condom on upside down, toss it and grab a new one! There's probably already fluid on that condom, which may contain sperm or infections.
- 6 Unroll the condom down the penis/sex-toy until it is completely unrolled down to the bottom of the penis/sex-toy. Run your hands down the sides a few times to ensure there are no air bubbles. This can totally be part of foreplay!

- 7 After ejaculation "cumming," while the penis is still erect, hold the condom at the bottom of the penis and carefully remove the condom without spilling any semen "cum."
- 8 Throw the condom away in the trash (do not flush it).
